



# 2024 Title IX Updates

**Title IX is a landmark federal civil rights law that was passed in 1972 to ensure everyone's Constitutional right to education is protected.**

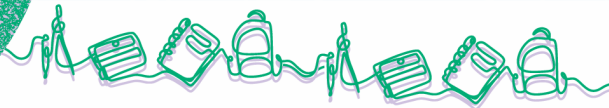
2024 updates to Title IX outlaw discrimination and harassment based on sexual orientation and gender identity. That means students and staff can utilize facilities, such as bathrooms and locker rooms, that align with their gender identity.

**The new rule is clear that transgender and nonbinary students and staff belong in school.**

In Arizona, some school districts believe they can opt-out of protecting the Constitutional right to discrimination-free education; BUT the updated rule is in effect. Let's be clear: students and staff have rights under Title IX to encounter educational spaces free from discrimination.

- Choose if / when / how to come out
- Live as their true gender (complete with pronouns and affirmed name)
- Express who they are & what they believe
- Date who they want
- Form a student group
- Not be misgendered or harassed
- Use facilities that align with their identity
- Report harassment without retaliation
